STOWFORD 75 YEAR REMEMBRANCE TREE

Dear Parishioners

Remembrance Day 2020 marked 75 years since the end of the Second World War. It has been remembered by parishioners every year since. In 1970 a tree was planted in the parish to mark the 25 year anniversary. Another was planted in 1995 to mark the 50 year anniversary. A suggestion was tabled last year to mark the 75 year anniversary. Since then we have identified where the first 2 trees were planted and Cllrs Leroy and Lorna St Louis have volunteered to clear the area around the existing trees and the council are to investigate options to permanently mark the location of these trees.

There has been much debate within the council as to the type and location of the tree. The Council has decided upon a *Cornus kousa* which is a large shrub or tree with two good seasons of interest. In early summer it bears white bracts with tiny flowers in the centre, set against the green leaves, and in autumn the leaves flare bronze and crimson. In a good year there will also be strawberry-like pink fruit in autumn. It is available with variegated leaves and flowers from white, white with a tinge of pink through to pink.

The *Cornus kousa* reaches maturity in 25 years which will be perfect timing for the 100 year anniversary. It grows between 4-8m with a 4m spread and enjoys a site in full sun to partial shade so is suitable for a variety of sites. Which leads us to the purpose of this article.....

We are now asking Stowford's parishioners to help choose a suitable location to site the tree which is accessible to everyone. Minutes of ordinary meeting No 697 held on Tuesday 4th May 2021

1. Finance- The following items were read and approved for Annual Governance & Accountability
 - 1.1.1 Asset register – signed by the chair
 - 1.1.2 Certificate of exemption, signed by the chair
 - 1.1.3 Annual Governance Statement – signed by the chair,
 - 1.1.4 Accounting Statements- signed by the chair.
 - 1.1.5 Confirmation of the dates of the period for the exercise of public rights were approved for the period 14th June – 23rd July 2021, proposed by Cllr Leroy St Louis, seconded by Cllr Lorna St Louis.
 - 1.2 Payments were approved for:- DALC £70.01, Caroline Harris Bookkeeping £150.00, Peter van Delft £176.80, HMRC £44.20, P van Delft – admin costs £77.50, proposed by Cllr Lorna St Louis, seconded by Cllr Hennessey
 - 1.3 R.F.O. Reported a credit balance after payments of £5822.87, proposed by Cllr Dunn, seconded by Cllr Law
 - 1.4 Review of bank signatories- updating bank account signatories to include the removal of former councillors and the inclusion of Cllr Lorna St Louis, proposed by Cllr Law, seconded by Cllr Hennessey
2. Meetings post May 6th return to ‘face to face’ meetings – The draft risk assessment and meeting procedures were adopted. Proposed by Cllr Lorna St Louis, seconded by Cllr Law. Cllr Hennessey recommended that anti-bacterial spray is used for the chairs. PPE equipment to be purchased by the clerk in time for the next meeting.
3. Planning Ref – 0178/21/HHO – Householder application for extension and modification to the rear including a 2nd storey master bedroom. Address – The Harris Arms, Portgate, Lewdown, EX20 4PZ, Council decision – Support, proposed by Cllr Lorna St Louis, seconded by Cllr Roberts. Planning Ref: - 0958/21/HHO – Householder application for installation of solar PV panels on roof of existing outbuilding, Address, Homeleigh, Sprytown, PL16 0AY, Council

- decision – support, proposed by Hennessey, seconded by Cllr Law.
4. Cllr Edmonds of WDBC reported that the council would be returning to Kilworthy Park again from 17th May for its meetings except that for committee meetings which may continue using virtual platforms. Drainage work on the main C822 has been completed, it is thought that this work will resolve the issue of surface water going across the highway near Sprytown Cross. The kerb cleaning between Sprytown Cross and Tinhay is thought to also improve the drainage.
 5. Reports from councillors. Cllr Roberts reported that two coaches were parked on land in the parish, WDBC enforcement team are dealing with the issue. Cllr Edmonds was thanked for his work in supporting the Parish Hall Committee with its support grants during this pandemic. The PHC will be upgrading the lighting, heating and kitchen in the near future. Cllr Edmonds mentioned that support from WDBC is still available through local grants for such work.
 6. Facebook - Parish council page, work is progressing to ensure that no discrimination takes place on the platform.
 7. 75 year Remembrance Tree – It was resolved to plant a Cornus Kousa (small to medium size tree, variety to be agreed). Plaque and text to be agreed at the next meeting.
 8. Bus shelter – Maintenance and repair – it was resolved that Cllrs Leroy and Lorna St Louis would clean and paint the Portgate bus shelter when the weather and time permits.
 9. Councillor vacancy. There is still a position vacant.

We have over 650 fiction books including *The Thursday Murder Club* the debut novel by Richard Osman and over 30 books by Michael Jecks set in the West Country.

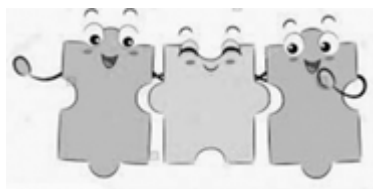

Minute No 736 Ordinary meeting held on Monday 29th March 2021

1. Members of the public – Two members present. One parishioner stated that the site of the old coach house will be tidied up soon. Another parishioner asked what progress was being made with regards to speeding and safety on the C822, the chair informed this would be dealt with on the next item, also when the Wig Wag west bound would be repaired, Cllr Southcott advised that this was being dealt with.
2. Speeding and Safety concerns on the C822 – Unfortunately Cllr Ball has not been able to obtain any information from his colleagues that is needed to progress further since the last full meeting.
3. Minutes of previous meeting 735 being a true reflection of that meeting was approved and signed by the chair.
Proposed Cllr Southcott, seconded Cllr Yeo.
4. Planning Ref: 0603/21/CLE – Certificate of lawfulness for existing siting of a mobile home and continued occupation for residential purposes. Address – Mobile Home, Widdacombe Barns, Lewdown, EX20 4EA Council decision – Support – Proposed Cllr Crocker, seconded Cllr Yeo.
Planning Ref: 4183/20/VAR - Application for variation of condition 12 (drainage details) on approved application
825/16/FUL, Address – Land at rear of Rowan Cottages, Lewdown. Council decision – Object – Proposed Cllr Andrews, seconded Cllr Dawe.
Planning Ref: 0606/21/HHO – Householder application for replacement roof to existing rear Conservatory. Address – Swallows, Lewdown, EX20 4BX, Council decision – Support – Proposed Cllr Metherell, seconded Cllr Wilkinson
Planning Ref: 1642752 – Application to name/number a new street for Viburnum S.W. Ltd (This application has been dealt with) Council decision – Schoolhayes and Brentor View.
5. Finance. 8.1 Authorise payment of the following; P. van Delft – Clerk salary (Feb - Mar) £388.60, HMRC – Paye £9.20, A Harrop – Zoom meetings £28.78, P. van Delft – Admin expenses £59.21, Mrs Sarah Nash – Defibrillator battery/pad pack £73.80 Vision ICT – Annual website support & hosting £150.00 Payments approved – Proposed Cllr Vanstone, seconded Cllr Southcott. 8.2 R.F.O. Reported a combined credit of £18,132.83. The report was approved, Proposed Cllr Southcott, seconded Cllr Andrews.

6. BT Telephone Kiosk – Unfortunately BT will not sell the Kiosk because it sits on BT land and is not the type of kiosk it allows to be sold.
 7. Councillor vacancy for Marystow Parish – a vacancy still stands.
 8. Cllr Mott (WDBC) provided the monthly report, this was circulated.
 9. Councillor reports: Cllr Yeo asked if the black bin waste trials were continuing, Cllr Southcott to enquire. Cllr Yeo also reported an accident near the Wye junction, with damage caused to the hedgerow. Cllr Wilkinson reported that he had undertaken a survey of the pavement from the sports ground to the school, the recommended width should be 2 mtrs however in some places it only measured 1 mtr, unfortunately at the narrowest point it will be difficult to widen the pavement. Cllr Vanstone reported potholes and poor metal on the Whiteborough Farm – Thrushelford Farm highway, Cllr Southgate to provide photos to D.H. Bridge stonework dislodging's on the bridge at Thrushelford, registered with DH ref 211409397, and at the bridge at Foxcombe registered with D.H. ref 211409398. Cllr Perkins reported that there were now many more pot-holes in Marystow lane, Cllr Harrop to register again. Cllr Andrews reported that drainage water from the Crossroads development is causing significant issues in the parish, Cllr Southcott is working with WDBC on the problem. Cllr Southcott reported that Speedwatch would be starting soon in the parish.
 10. Emergency Plan booklet – a grant from Devon Communities Together has now been approved. It was resolved to approve the printing of the booklet for a cost of £210, Proposed Cllr Yeo, seconded Cllr Andrews. The final draft to be circulated by Cllr Southcott.
 11. The Ramps – Cllr Perkins is looking into additional fund raising, Section 106 money from the developments could be forthcoming within the next 2 years. Planning permission is required for the play equipment and changes to the land at The Ramps, this to be addressed at the next meeting. The Ramps is registered as a Village green.
 12. Snow Warden vacancy – No response to advertisement yet.
 13. Future Parish Council meetings – A resumption of public meetings is scheduled to start on 24th May (subject to jurisdiction), Cllr Harrop provided a draft risk assessment and council meeting procedure to provide public and councillor safety against Covid 19 at the meetings.
 14. Correspondence – Lewdown W.I. request, HMRC - Paye credit balance.
- Items for inclusion at a future meeting to include, Commemorative VE Day plaque – cost and inscription.

Date & time of next scheduled meeting, Annual Parish's, 26th April 2021, 7.30pm, this will be a virtual Zoom meeting with guest speaker Clive Leworthy from Airband high speed internet.
